

My Dear Friends,

Many centuries before the coming of Christ the prophet Isaiah pointed to God doing a new thing among his people, `Behold I am doing a new thing' (Isaiah 43:19). The first new thing was preparing God's people to expect the Messiah who would liberate his people, and the second was the pouring out of a new Spirit. The Spirit would descend on the Messiah: `And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and fear of the Lord' (Isaiah 11:1-2). Through Baptism we receive the fullness of the Spirit and in Confirmation we were strengthened in the Spirit. Please pray for those preparing for Confirmation next week.
