CAFOD CAFOD is urging all parishes in England and Wales to call on our Prime Minister to show leadership nationally and internationally to prevent climate change pushing people deeper into poverty. We'll be joining the Catholics across the world, as part of the Global Catholic Climate Movement, in signing a global petition letter. The petition letter will be presented to the world leaders shortly before the UN climate talks in Paris at the end of November 2015. The petition is at the back of the Church, please do sign it - James Ronan (there are also a few copies of the Holy Father's encyclical "Si Laudato" on climate change at the back of Church.

The program began 11th July with national conference in Birmingham at which were 850 delegates representing every diocese (37 from this diocese). Conference to provide resources, through local reps for every parish to become equipped for evangelism in the community. Each parish will be asked to form an evangelism group (consisting of 3 members) to enthuse the project in the parish. **Proclaim 15** is the result of Pope Francis' document *Evangelii Gaudium* **Please pray for the project and please get involved as it starts to take shape in our parish.**
