SPUC This year is 50th Anniversary since Abortion Act in this country. To mark the event the Diocese will be holding two mtgs locally and be addressed by 2 members of the national SPUC speakers team. The events will be on **Tuesday 21st March at St. Cuthbert's Buckfast Abbey 1.45pm - 3.45pm** and at the **Plymouth Cathedral Centre 7.15 - 9.15pm.** Since 1967 8.7 million babies have been killed by state-sponsored abortion in England, Wales and Scotland.
