ALL SAINTS DAY: This is a **Holy Day of Obligation**. There will be a Vigil Mass on **Tues 31st Oct at 7pm** and a Mass on the day at **10am**.

Tuesday onwards: Re-plastering of the new Sacristy which will be completely sealed off during this work, please do not attempt to enter. The storage cupboards should be in place on the rear row of pews soon. The architect is currently awaiting a report from the Structural Engineer so that tendering can take place for the structure at the back of Church.

FORMATION DAYS FOR CATECHISTS A four-part course for all catechists and 'would be' catechists who help pass on the faith in any way, by involvement in Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, RCIA, Marriage Preparation programmes or Children's Liturgy.
