FR. JOHN'S DIARY:

ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY: Many thanks to everyone who fulfilled their obligation by attending Mass on this Solemnity last week.

SECOND COLLECTION: Sunday 26th August—This will be for Plymouth Catholic Children's Society.

COGIMENTA: "Mercy will always be greater than any sin, no-one can put a limit on the love of the all-forgiving God. Just by looking at him, just raising our eyes from ourselves and our wounds, we leave an opening for the action of his grace. Jesus performs miracles with our sins, with what we are, with our nothingness, with our wretchedness." Pope Francis, The Name of God is Mercy.

WEST END DEVELOPMENT: Work will begin at the west end on Monday 10th September; by then, we will need to completely clear the west end of the Church. The work will be completed by Easter. The west end will be screened off during this period and the Church will become a "building site" from Mon-Fri of each week with strictly no admittance. There will inevitably be some disruption and dust from time to time.

Fr. John has negotiated with the Vicar of St. Eustachius Anglican Church for us to celebrate Mass on a Monday, Tuesday and Thursday (Saturday and Sunday will be in church as usual). Fr. John has also asked the Vicar if we can use his Church for funerals if the occasion arises.
