FR. JOHN: Has been advised not to drive during the hours of darkness because of an eye condition. Until this is rectified, it will mean that he will be restricted to driving just in daylight. This will also mean that he will have to make the twice weekly journey to and from St Austell by bus and train.

FR. JOHN: will be at the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham this week where, with the priests of the Ordinariate, he will join the three Ordinariates from this country, Australia and the United States of America for a pilgrimage. Devotions and Mass will take place on Saturday as usual.

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY: October is the month of the Rosary; the Holy Father has asked us all to pray the Rosary each day during October. The *Rosary is prayed on each Saturday after Mass.*

ALL SOULS DAY: This will be transferred to *Saturday, 3rd November with a Requiem Mass at 10am.* A list will be at the back of Church for the names of the souls to be remembered at the Mass. Please print names clearly and try to be at the mass if you put a name on the list.

SECOND COLLECTION: The next 2nd Collection will be on 21st October which is World Mission Sunday and the collection will be for *Missio.*

WEST END DEVELOPMENT: Work has begun on the West End, therefore the Church is now inaccessible from Mon-Fri of each week. Mass during the week (except Saturday) will be celebrated at St Eustachius Anglican Church. Mass on Saturday and Sunday will be in Church as normal. During this period, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will now take place on Saturdays from 9am until 9.50am as well as the Sacrament of Penance.
