#### Pilgrim Virgin Statue and Fatima Relics to Visit The Cathedral Church of St Mary & St Boniface—10 May 2025

The Cathedral Church of St Mary & St Boniface will host the Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima and relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco on 10 May 2025, in commemoration of the Centenary of the Five First Saturdays devotion.

The day will include a procession and enthronement of the Fatima statue, followed by Mass and opportunities to venerate the saints' relics. Participants will pray the Rosary for world peace and attend informative talks and videos about Fatima's messages. A book table with devotional materials will be available, and attendees can enrol in the Brown Scapular devotion. The event concludes with a Holy Hour and Benediction.

The important vote for all MPs on the assisted suicide legislation, known as the *Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill*, has been delayed by 3 weeks and is likely to take place on 16th May. The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their Member of Parliament and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law.
