Closure of St Peter's - Crownhill

The Diocese of Plymouth has closed St Peter's Catholic Church, the car park and the presbytery in Crownhill, Plymouth, from 10 July 2025 as a result of the findings of a structural survey.

Canon Paul Cummins said: "We are very sorry that we have had to close St Peter's church in Crownhill with immediate effect. This is not a decision that we have taken lightly: it was necessary to ensure the safety of our school pupils, parents and teachers as well as the priests, parishioners and staff."

Canon Paul has asked people across the Deanery and Diocese for their continued support and prayers as the parish explores new arrangements to celebrate the sacraments and to provide pastoral support to the local community and to sustain the activities provided at the church. Fr Jonathan Bielawski, the parish priest, is putting arrangements in place so that parishioners will still be able to gather together to worship as a community.
