Since the scheme was introduced in 2011, we have raised a whopping £52,319.72 which is an absolutely staggering amount of money. And in 2025 alone, so far we have raised just over £31,000 which is a phenomenal amount of money. Items that can be put into your parish Orange Box include: stamp collections- first day covers or old envelopes and postcards pre 1950, coins and banknotes – any and all, old and new, from all over the world, obsolete or otherwise, precious metals -including broken jewelry, old trophies, gold, silver etc, metals including ornaments -metal toys, keys and locks, metal cutlery – any age and any condition, costume jewelry, medals, small antiques and collectibles, watches – digital, quartz or manual wind – working or not, any Catholic religious memorabilia such as rosaries, crucifixes.
